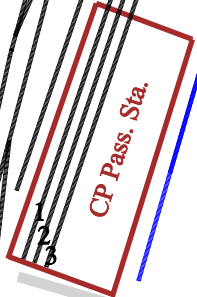

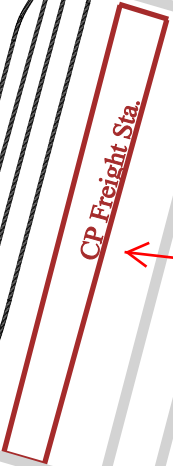


Dual Gauge track is colored blue

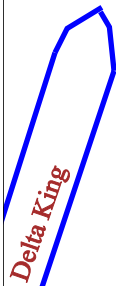
